There are two phases of the admission process to the nursing program. **1)** Transfer students must be admitted to SCSU **the semester prior** to applying to the Nursing Department. Students must apply to SCSU admissions in the fall semester and be accepted by December 1st. **2)** Once accepted, students then apply to the Nursing Department **before the Feb. 1st deadline** for the program which starts the following fall. *Application is made when the student has completed at least seven of the 11 nursing prerequisites (noted with ♦) as well as most, if not all, of the SCSU University Requirements. All nursing prerequisites must be completed prior to enrolling in nursing courses in the fall semester.* Admission is competitive, with a **GPA of 2.7** being the minimum considered for acceptance.
